

Naza Group rewards Paralympians gold medallists with residence, cars

KUALA LUMPUR: The two Malaysian Paralympians who won gold at the Rio 2016 Paralympics will each be rewarded with a residential suite and an all-new Kia Sportage sport utility vehicle.

Naza Corporation Holdings chairman and chief executive officer SM Nasarudin SM Nasimuddin said the residential suite awarded to gold medallist paralympians Mohamad Ridzuan Mohd Puzi and Ziyad Zolkefli will be the Trion 888 at Equine Park.

The property, developed by Naza Corporation Holdings property arm, Naza TTDI Sdn Bhd is priced at RM350,000.

It has a built-up area of 450 square feet and full facilities comprising swimming pool, multipurpose room, gymnasium, changing room, lift, laundry facility and surau.

The project is expected to be completed by end of 2017.

The Kia Sportage meanwhile

is priced at RM121,888 each and comes with a five-year warranty with unlimited mileage.

Nasarudin, who is also Malaysia Paralympics Council president and is currently in Rio, said the achievements by Mohamad Ridzuan and Ziyad had not only inspired other athletes but all Malaysians.

“Our Malaysian paralympians have shown their mettle despite the odds.

“This is how we show that Malaysia Boleh!” he said in a statement here yesterday.

Mohamad Ridzuan won a gold in the 100m T36 men’s event with a time of 12.07 seconds ahead of Yang Yifei of China (12.20s) and Rodrigo Parreira da Silva of Brazil (12.54s).

Shot-putter Ziyad bagged Malaysia’s second gold through the Shot Put F20 (intellectual disability) event after hurling the shot to a distance of 16.84m, setting a new world record. -
